## ALTERATIONS TO CONDITIONS OF ASSIGNMENT OF LOADLINES

Ship's Name " EDDYBEACH " Official No. 184537.

Port of Registry LONDON.

This ship has been under survey at GIBRALTAR

on 23rd October, 1954 and the following alterations to the conditions of

assignment of loadlines have now been effected/found:—

Alteration to Chain Locker.

The chain locker has been enlarged by increasing it's depth by 6 ft.

A strongly constructed steel plate watertight casing 8' 0" wide by 4' 9" long welded between the top of chain locker and the Forecastle deck in place of chain pipes which have been removed.

Access to this casing is obtained through a strongly framed and constructed steel hinged watertight door 3' 0" high x 2' 0" wide with 2 ft sill at the after end of the casing. The door is fitted with quick closing handles.


