



Extract from letter 23.4.43 from Mr.Manley, Glasgow.

I have your note of the 21st instant about the "ROCKWOOD PARK", St.John S.B.&.D D.Co's Yard No.14, and shall be glad if you will inform Mr.Dykes that Mr.Bennett at New York reported in October, 1941, that this ship was of the "Gray" type (similar to Messrs W.Gray & Co's Yard Nos.1119/20 etc. and sister ships building by other firms in the U.K.). No copies of plans approved by Mr.Bennett have been received, and I believe that plans of the Gray 310' ship were sent out to Canada from this country by the Ministry. I assume, therefore, that Mr.Dykes can deal with the case as a sister to Messrs. W.Gray & Co's ships."
