We request that the Committee of Lloyd's Register will instruct the Society's Surveyors to Specially Survey during Construction the Hull, Engines and Boilers of the Vessel No. 1290 building by Messrs. Deutsche Werft, Hamburg for Messrs. Trelleborgs Angsfartygs Nyd Aktiebolag of 1290 Dw- Tons. Length 198' Breadth 32', Depth 15' intended to be Classed +100 A 1 Carrying Petroleum in Bulk, strengthened for Navig. in Ice

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees for the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connection therewith.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:-
