

Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in DECEMBER 1950 AT KIEL



ALTERATIONS NOW EFFECTED: -

- 1.) Lengthening of the hull by 10.065 mm - 33,02'
- 2.) Fitting of 2 additional oil hatches for No. III cargo oil tanks (1 p.s., 1 s.s.) of same dimensions, (see above sketch) coamings, covers and closing arrangements as the existing 8 cargo oil hatchways, viz.: 1140 x 760 mm, coaming 200 x 12 mm with steel hatch covers of 12,5 mm thickness and hemp packing.
- 3.) Fitting of 2 man holes and doors for access to the now installed No. 3 cofferdam, 400 x 600 mm, coaming 250 x 10 mm with steel hatch covers and hemp packing.
- 4.) Fitting of 2 additional ventilators for the now installed No. 3 cofferdam of substantial construction coaming 760 x 8 mm, E.W. to deck plating and closed by steel covers and canvas covers.
