With regard to your enquiry of the 25th March, I am informed by Lloyd's Sub-Agents here, who have been making enquiries on behalf of their principals, that the Egyptian Authorities have agreed to release the vessel to her Owners. It now remains for some acceptable means of delivering the vessel to be agreed upon.

The vessel is at present lying afloat in the harbour, under guard.

I will keep you informed of any developments in the case. I may add that it is unlikely that the Authorities will permit any work on the vessel here other than the minimum necessary to remove her.
