The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

The class is subject to permanent repairs to indented shell plates (p & s) at the first convenient opportunity and to (a bower anchor and 45 fathoms of chain cable being supplied and to 2 bower anchors and stream anchor on board being submitted to the Statutory Test).

The NEWCASTLE Surveyors report the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom coated, a General Examination due 2.48 held and minor repairs effected.

Indented shell plates as above specially examined and continue efficient meantime.

IT IS SUBMITTED the vessel is eligible to remain as classed with record of docking survey 12.47 subject as above and to have the notation "Examined 12.47" valid for 12 months, as recommended, assigned.
