Dear Sir:

I am in receipt of your letter of the 7th instant having reference to Montreal Report No. 5644 on the S.S. "FORT TADOUSSAC".

I have been in communication with the Quebec Surveyors, where this vessel was completed, and they intimate that, while the first submission of the builders was to make the face plate fitted on the face of the 12" channel frames 9" x 3/16". This was later changed (at the request of this office) to 6" x 9/16". They further state that a similar error in reporting is contained in the First Entries of the "FORT LA MAUNE", "FORT CHAMBLY" and "PRINCE ALBERT PARK".

I shall be glad if you will rectify these. I have requested the Surveyors concerned to be careful in future in checking over their First Entry Reports in detail before the same are forwarded for the Committee's consideration.
