Dear Sirs,

S. With reference to your letters of the 8th and 12th instant and previous correspondence respecting the Motorship "EL KARIM", I have to acquaint you that the reports of the surveys carried out at Bordeaux and Rotterdam between August and March last have now received consideration.

As a result of these inspections the vessel has been classed "LOCAL Carrying petroleum in bulk, For Service on the Atlantic & Mediterranean Coasts of French North Africa and Spanish Morocco including Tangier and Gibraltar". A Docking Date of 3,48 Sch., has been assigned subject to the spare bower anchor being replaced by one of not less than 18 cwt at the first opportunity, also to the spare gear being brought up to Rule requirements. Records of S.S.La.R.-3,48 and LMC 3,48 have also been assigned in respect of the Special Survey of the hull and machinery and Classification Certificates to this effect are enclosed, in duplicate, as desired for transmission to the Owners.

I think it well to add that in addition to the records previously referred to one of S 1,48 relative to the Screwshaft Survey is also being inserted in the Register Book with a notation of Classed 3,48.
