Value by REPAIRS TO ENGINES AND BOILERS DUE TO DAMAGE THROUGH--

This Motor Tanker was built in 1944 to American Bureau requirements and Classification with this Society is now desired.

First Entry reports and some plans have been examined. Details and arrangements are such as might be accepted.

The scantlings of the starting air receivers have not been obtained, but the Surveyor has tested them to twice the working pressure with satisfactory results.

The vessel has been examined in dry dock and the requirements of LMC and TS surveys carried out.

The spare gear is not yet up to Rule requirements.

IT IS SUBMITTED that this vessel is eligible for the Record LMC 3.48,  
Both S 1.48.
