Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your cablegram of yesterday's date respecting the case of the Steamer "CRISTINA" ex "NERO", and note that the vessel has left Genoa for Catania without survey, and that the Owners do not wish the class to be retained.

As the Second Special Survey No. 2 is now overdue and considerable repairs are required, the Committee, who have given the matter their careful consideration to-day, have decided to expunge the vessel's class from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Rules, and I cabled this decision to you, as below, with a view to your communicating with the Owners on the subject.

- KOTSI = class has been expunged with a red line on account of non-compliance with the Rules
