M.V. "SEPIA" have been adjusted for
Local Magnetic Deviation and are now in perfect order. Tables showing
the effect of such deviation have this day been handed to the Master.

The deviations have been ascertained on the various courses both with
the dynamo stopped and with it running at full speed, with the electric
current on and "off" all circuits in the vicinity of the Compasses.

The deviations so found are practically identical under both conditions
and are in accordance with the tables furnished this day to the Master.
