The cases of these ships have been reviewed by the Committee, and in view of the fact that a second four-yearly Special Survey period has elapsed in each case since the last date of survey recorded in the Register Book, the Committee feel in the absence of any proposal for dealing with the overdue surveys, that they would not be justified in continuing the classes of these ships.

They have, therefore, given instructions for records to be made in the Register Book indicating that the class in each case has been withdrawn.

In the cases of the "CANADIAN CONSTRUCTOR" and "CIUDAD DE DETROIT" instructions have also been given for the class of the refrigerated cargo installations to be withdrawn.

I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners accordingly.
