I have to inform you that I am in receipt of a letter from the Society's Paris Office enclosing a translation of one which has been received from the Owners of the steamer "VENDEMIARE", in which they state that their Superintendent Mr. Codet has advised them from Hamburg that the hull and machinery certificates are not on board the vessel, and they desire that these documents should be delivered without delay to the Master, who will leave Hamburg on the 10th instant.

The First Entry Certificates for this vessel were forwarded to you on the 23rd July, and it is concluded that they should have reached the Owners long before this, but in view of the request now received I think it well to enclose herewith certified copies of the First Entry Certificate of the hull ( without midship section ) and of the machinery, and shall be glad if you will see that these are handed to the Master as desired.

The charge for these certified copies is 5/-, which perhaps you will be good to collect.
