Dear Sirs,

S. With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the motor ship "CESARE", which vessel it is understood has now been purchased by your goodselves, I have to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Genoa have forwarded to this Office a copy of your letter of the 15th ultimo, addressed to them, intimating that it is not your intention to retain the vessel's class with this Society, and in the circumstances the Committee, who have had the case before them at their meeting today, have given instructions for this vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
