I beg to acquaint you that the General Committee have today had before them the cases of the steamers "ENZYU MARU" and "HUKUZYU MARU", referred to in your letters of the 1st February last addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Kobe, from which it is noted that you do not desire to continue the vessels' classification in the Society's Register Book.

In the circumstances the Committee have decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and Three Dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, in each instance, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
