F. Dear Sir,

With reference to Mobile report No. 1697 on the tanker "EDWIN B. DE GOLIA", it is observed that a summer freeboard of 4'-7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " has been marked on the vessel's sides, the record in the Register Book being 5'-5", as assigned by this Society in 1917.

It is also noted that a Load Line inspection has now been held, but the report and verification forms, which were stated to be attached to the survey report, do not appear to have reached this office.

I shall therefore be glad if you will be good enough to forward these documents and let me know whether freeboards have now been assigned by this Society and, if not, particulars of those assigned by the American Bureau should be sent, in order that the record of freeboard and draught in the Register Book may be amended.
