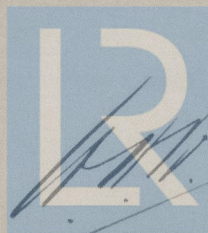
The vessel has been sold and the new Owners do not desire to maintain the classification.
