M. Dear Sirs,

I duly received Mr. Dippie's letter of the 29th ultimo, respecting the S.S. "TAIKOO WAN YI", Messrs. Sir Raylton Dixon & Co's No. 617, and with regard thereto I have to inform you that -

- (1) The riveting of the shell plating will be accepted in this instance.
- (2) Brackets will require to be fitted at the heels of the hatch end pillars.
- (3) As no ceiling is laid on the tank top, some protection must be fitted over the manhole covers on tank top.

The three plans forwarded with Mr. Dippie's letter are returned herewith.

At the same time I have to add that the Owners have been interviewed regarding these matters and a copy of this letter is being supplied to them at their request in order that they may send it to the Builders.
