Dear Sirs,

With reference to your letter of the 13th instant respecting the "C" Type Standard Ship, No. 617, S.S. "TAIKOO WAN YI" built by you, I have to state that in order to render the vessel eligible for classification with this Society as desired by the Owners, it will be necessary for the Society's Surveyors to survey the vessel and her Machinery, and satisfy themselves that they have been built in accordance with the plans approved by this Society for the Shipping Controller for the "C" Type Standard Ship.

Upon receipt of a satisfactory report from the Surveyors, the vessel could be recommended to the Committee for the LOCAL class, but without the Special Survey mark which signifies that she has been built under Special Survey.

I have further to state that an inclusive fee of £90 for Hull and Machinery for the survey and classification of the vessel will be charged.
