A report on the completion of the Survey for classification of this ship has now been received from Holland and the Committee have assigned a class of "B.S. Coasting Service, Cargo battens not fitted".

As will be seen from the Register Book, this vessel was converted in 1949 but there is no record in this Office as to when she was first constructed and as it is considered desirable that a vessel classed with this Society shall have a date of build in the Register Book, it will be appreciated if you will kindly enquire of Messrs. G. Brown & Company as to whether they are able to state the vessel's Yard No. and when she was constructed by them.

It is understood the vessel was formerly named U.S.L.C. "P.12".
