The COPENHAGEN Surveyors report (11.49), this ship damaged by a mine explosion, and subsequently examined afloat at Nakskov and later on a pontoon at Svendborg. Temporary repairs were effected to enable the ship to proceed under tow and without cargo to Rotterdam, where she will again be dry docked for permanent repairs.

The ROTTERDAM Surveyors have been informed accordingly.

IT IS SUBMITTED ACTION as regards CLASSIFICATION be DEFERRED pending the carrying out of permanent repairs.
