In September 1953 the Vancouver Surveyors stated that the vessel has been laid up at that port for 18 months, since that date various negotiations for the sale of the ship fell through. On the 19th February 1954 the vessel's class was qualified with the notation "Laid up- surveys overdue) and on the 4th February 1955 a notation "Class suspended" was added. This latter notation was amended to "Laid up - surveys overdue 10.53." on the reprint of the 1959/1960 Register Book.

It is now stated that the vessel has been sold and the machinery removed. The vessel has been converted to a floating restaurant to be tied up at a permanent berth in Vancouver harbour. It is stated that the alterations will be completed early in July, 1959.
