Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter of the 4th instant regarding the steamer "LADY ALEXANDRA" and note that the Owners are hoping to negotiate a sale to an East Coast firm who are likely to convert her to a car ferry.

In the event of this sale materialising the Committee will not object to the Special Survey being deferred until her arrival on the East Coast for conversion, but this of course in no way covers her for class for the voyage round.

The restricted class of 'British Columbia Coasting Service' will be retained in the Register Book meantime, and it will be a Government responsibility to cover her for load line for the contemplated voyage.
