We duly received your letter of the 22nd September last advising that the Committee are agreeable to this vessel's class remaining undisturbed in the Society's Register Book on the understanding that the outstanding matters of survey are dealt with before she is again placed in commission, and that any prospective purchasers are advised of the overdue surveys.

The Owners have now advised us that they are negotiating the sale of the ship to the Northumberland Ferries, Ltd., Charlottetown, P.E.I. with a view to her being converted for service as a Car Ferry.

The Owners state that they have advised the prospective Purchasers of the outstanding surveys and in the event of the sale being arranged they propose drydocking the ship for a general condition survey, Annual Boiler Survey, Starboard Screwshaft Survey, and temporary re-inforcement of the vessel to the satisfaction of the Canadian Steamship Inspectors for the voyage to Halifax.

We shall be pleased if you will kindly advise us if the Special Survey may be deferred under these circumstances until the ship's arrival in Halifax within the next two or three months.
