Tugs "ARTHUR BEMELMANS"
& "VIVI"

With reference to your letter of the 20th and mine of the 30th January last I enclose for your information copies of letters dated the 15th and 29th July received from Mr. Lascelles of Antwerp, from which it will be noted that the "ARTHUR BEMELMANS" is laid up and that only the "VIVI" is to be submitted to inspection.

With regard to the "VIVI" I enclose a memorandum dealing with the requirements for reinstatement of class in the Society's Register Book so far as the hull is concerned.

A complete Special Survey of the machinery should be carried out and the screwshaft drawn for examination. Any alterations that may have been made since the vessel's class was suspended which might affect the class should be submitted for consideration. For your guidance photostat copies of all the machinery First Entry reports are also enclosed, together with a copy of New York report (Rpt.9) No.48233.

A photostat copy of the Rpt.C.11 for the "VIVI" was sent to you on the 4th February last.
