Thank you for your letter dated 15th January in enclosure, from which we are pleased to learn that the surveys of the above named ships may be undertaken in the future.

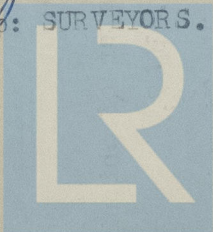

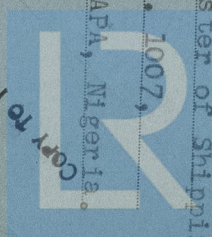
