S. With reference to Glasgow first entry report No.49473 on the tug "ARTHUR BEMELMANS", I have to say it is concluded that the safety valves are in accordance with the Rules, but I shall be glad if you will ascertain from the Surveyor and let me know if this is so.

At the same time the Surveyor should state the size, number and description of the safety valves, the pressure to which they were adjusted under steam and whether easing gear is fitted, as this information has been omitted from the report.

The classification certificates are enclosed, for issue if the case is in order.


