Dear Sirs,

S. With reference to previous correspondence which has taken place between us respecting the Motor Trawler "URANIA" ex "M.M.S.1084", I beg to acquaint you that the report of the survey carried out by the Society's Surveyors at Southampton in January 1947/February 1948 has today received the consideration of the Committee.

As a result of this inspection the vessel has been classed "8A- For Fishing Purposes from 9,47" with Docking Date 9,47 Sou. Notations of IMC 2,48 and S 5,47 O.G. have also been assigned in respect of the Special Survey of the machinery and the Screwshaft Survey, together with a record of Classed 9,47 and other appropriate notations.

I have to add that the torsional vibration characteristics of the main propelling machinery have not been investigated and should it be desired I shall have pleasure in arranging for the Society's Surveyors to carry out an investigation in this respect. In the meantime the machinery certificate, which is now enclosed together with one for the hull, has been endorsed "Torsional vibration characteristics not investigated".
