It is noted that the above tanker was last seen in drydock by the Society's Surveyors in August 1959.

I shall be glad to learn the Owners' proposed arrangements for a further docking survey to be held.

We have now been informed by the local office of Messrs. J.W. Cook & Co., Ltd., that this vessel is not at present under their control for survey requirements.

They do state, however, that she is used only for the carriage of edible vegetable oils and that her class should be allowed to lapse as is their normal practice.

The Owners would therefore be obliged if this case could receive the necessary attention with a view to a notation being recorded in the Register Book indicating that the class of the ship has been withdrawn at the Owners' request.
