YACIMIENTOS PETROLIFEROS FISCALES  
(Argentine Government)

I duly received your letter of the 11th instant regarding certain ships of the above fleet, the contents of which have been noted.

The cases of the "DIRECTOR MADARIAGA", "SAN LORENZO", "COMODORO RIVADAVIA" and "ISLAS ORCADAS" have today received the consideration of the Committee, who have given instructions for a notation to be recorded in the Register Book indicating that the class of each of these ships has been withdrawn at the Owners' request.

In the case of the "ISLAS MALVINAS", however, in view of the fact that no arrangements had been made to carry out the considerably overdue surveys under the supervision of the Society's Surveyors, the Committee gave instructions for a notation to be recorded in the Register Book indicating that the class of the ship has been expunged on account of non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners accordingly.
