With reference to the London letter of the 22nd. instant regarding the First Entry Report on the above vessel, I beg to inform you that a connection from the donkey boiler is fitted to the circulating inlet.

The donkey boiler is fitted with two direct spring loaded safety valves each 1.5/8" diam, combined area of which is 4.14 sq. ins.

The safety valves were adjusted under steam to 150 lbs.

The sizes of compression rings were F.V. $\frac{11}{32}$ "
A.V. 5/16".

The safety valves are fitted with easing gear.
I regret that these items were omitted from my report.
