S. With reference to the Glasgow First Entry Report No. 48540 of survey of the motorship "SIGRID" it is concluded that a connexion from the Boilers has been fitted to the circulating inlet as required by section 41 of the Rules for steel ships (strengthening for ice navigation), but I shall be much obliged if you will kindly enquire of the Surveyors whether this is so.

At the same time I shall be glad to learn the number, description and area of the donkey boiler safety valves and the pressure to which they were adjusted; also whether they are fitted with easing gear.
