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Dear Sir:-

T. I duly received your letter of the 31st October last regarding the fees and expenses due to the New York, Philadelphia and Pittsburgh Offices which are outstanding against the Dolomite Marine Corporation and in reply I may say that the latest statement I have received from the Trustee in this bankruptcy proceeding is to the effect that they expect progress will soon be made when the allowances for service in the reorganization period are determined. However, in view of the debts of preferred creditors, such as taxes, the Trustees state that it is extremely doubtful that there will be a dividend for general creditors.

In view of this statement, which is in line with my own opinion in the matter, I think no useful purpose is being served in keeping these items on our books and I recommend for consideration that the amounts in question be written off.

I am enclosing a further copy of the voucher in respect of the payment of \$210.75 for professional services rendered by the Rochester correspondents of Messrs. Duer, Strong and Whitehead in


