We are in receipt of your letter of 1st inst.  
requesting informations on various vessels:

"NAVIDAD" As intimated in our letter of the 2nd instant on  
the "NORINA" we have received no reply to our enquiry  
addressed to the Owners.

"JOAN MOLLER" The Registered Owners inform us that the vessel is  
trading out of Shanghai and they have no facilities  
for carrying out surveys. It is our opinion that the  
Beneficiary Owners have control of the ship and  
therein lies the difficulty.

"NORELG" Your enquiry of 20th March last was passed on to the  
Owners in our letter of 25th March but so far no  
reply has been received.

We think this an appropriate time to point out the  
difficulty we experience in obtaining informations on vessels of the  
types listed above. On receipt of your enquired ~~we~~ we contact the  
Owners by telephone, when possible, or by letter, and immediately  
on receipt of the information required we forward it to you. In the  
event no information is received we do not write to you as we feel  
the volume of correspondence handled through this Office is already  
sufficient without further adding to it.
