ACTION and NOTATION of "ss. Shi.- 8.48" are DEFERRED for completion of Special Survey.

The YOKOHAMA Surveyors report the vessel examined in dry dock, bottom coated, ~~and~~ the SPECIAL SURVEY as above completed, and repairs effected to No. 3 D.B. tank riveting etc.

(The requirements of an Annual Survey complied with.)

The centre girder in this tank was found to be leaking slightly in way of top angle and the Owners' request to postpone permanent repairs until next drydocking is recommended for approval.

Temporary repairs effected to 2 leaky rivets in deep frames of Deep Tanks (p & s) and permanent repairs recommended at the next drydocking.

IT IS SUBMITTED the vessel is eligible to remain as classed by the British Corporation, with record of docking 11.50, subject to defective shell rivets in way of deep frames in deep tanks (p & s) being renewed and to permanent repairs to centre girder riveting in No. 3 D.B. tank at the next drydocking; and to have notations of "ss. Shi.-8.48" and "A.S.11.50" assigned as recommended.
