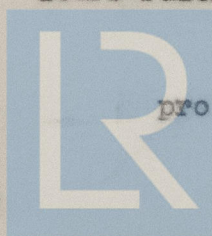
With reference to my letter of the 13th September last, respecting the steamer "LAKE NEUCHATEL" I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Cardiff reported that it was not possible for the repairs recommended by them to be carried out prior to the vessel's leaving that port, and action in regard to the granting of the year of grace for the carrying out of the 3rd Special Survey No.1 was accordingly deferred by the Committee.

In the circumstances I shall be obliged if you will kindly let me know whether you are in a position to state what arrangements you propose making for the above repairs to receive attention, for the Main Boiler Survey - due at the end of June last - to be carried out, and for the Donkey Boiler Survey to be completed by the adjustment of the safety valves under steam.
