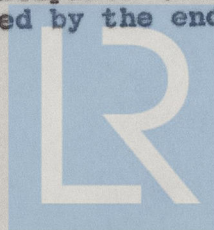

Reverting to your letter dated the 1st ultimo, I have to inform you that the Reports of the survey carried out by the Society's Rotterdam Surveyors between the 27th August and 8th September have now received the consideration of the Committee.

As a result of this inspection, fresh records of Docking Survey 9,64 and Screwshaft Examination 9,64 have been assigned, and the Committee have continued the vessel's class subject to the following items receiving attention by the times stated:-

- ✓ 1. Circular escape hatch on deck (starboard side aft) (temporarily repaired), to sanitary-discharge pipes in steering E. R., side scuttles in poop spaces etc., also to deckhouse and masthouse doors etc., covers on fiddley openings, and to set in bulwark in way of No. 1 hatch (port side) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary by the end of November next.
- ✓ 2. Wasted stay and plain tubes in the port boiler and starboard box of the starboard boiler and air heater tubes of all three boilers (thin) being renewed by the end of this month.
- ✓ 3. Main engine bedplate (Metalocked 1.63) being examined by the end of November next.

When item 2 above has been dealt with, the vessel will be eligible to a fresh notation of Main Boiler Survey 11.63.

It is concluded that the above matters will receive attention on the vessel's arrival in Greece, and a copy of this letter is being forwarded to the Piraeus Surveyors for their information.
