THIS IS TO CERTIFY that acting at the request of Messrs. SMITH, BELL & CO., (PHILIPPINES), INC., Lloyd's Agents, Cebu City, Philippines, the undersigned Registered Marine Surveyors-Engineers did, on 27th day of May, 1964 and subsequent dates, attend the Liberian steel screw steamer "AKAMAS" of Beyrouth, Official Number B-1185, Call Letters O-D-H-Q, of 7285 gross tons, 5147 net tons, as vessel lay afloat alongside Pier No. 1-North, Cebu City, Philippines, in order to examine and report upon the condition of the Starboard Boiler for continuous service. For particulars, see the report as follows:

1. The Starboard Scotch Boiler and its mountings and fittings were examined internally and externally and considered satisfactory.
2. The Starboard Scotch Boiler was subjected to hydrostatic test pressure of 240 lbs. psi., and found or made tight. Defective (weeping) tubes rolled and proven tight.
3. All attached valves and boiler mountings were generally examined and considered satisfactory.

The undersigned Surveyor considers the above boiler to be in satisfactory condition at this time and fit for continuous service at its allowable working pressure. ::::::::::::::
