With reference to the telephone conversation Mr. Medinos had with this Office on the 27th April, also to your letter of the 15th April and previous correspondence, I have to inform you that the Society's Surveyors at Yokohama have cabled stating that the port and centre boilers were to be surveyed at that port but they have been advised the repairs to the starboard boiler would be completed when the vessel arrived at Manila.

The Committee have approved this arrangement on the understanding that the ship will arrive at Manila at an early date for the repairs and re-examination of the starboard boiler, referred to in my communication dated 31st December, 1963, to receive attention.

I shall be glad if you will let me know as soon as possible, for the information of the Committee, when the vessel is expected to arrive at Manila and the arrangements proposed to be made to carry out the Screwshaft Survey, due at the end of June 1964, as requested in my letter dated the 13th April.
