Reverting to my letter of the 14th March last, I have to inform you that this ship was surveyed at Piraeus during March/April at which time the Metalock repairs to the main engine bedplate were again examined and found to remain efficient in the meantime.

It was recommended, however, that these repairs be re-examined before the end of October 1963 and the Committee have continued the class subject to this matter receiving attention by the time stated.

The class has also been continued subject to the propeller, underwater fastenings and sea valves being specially examined at the next drydocking.
