## CLASSING LETTER.

10171 "AKAMAS". As recommended except that the class has been continued subject also to the propeller, underwater fastenings and sea valves being specially examined at the next drydocking and in this respect I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 29th May.

10223 "OVERSEAS PIONEER". As recommended except that a notation of SS 5.63 will be assigned on completion of the Continuous Survey of the machinery.

According to our records the following items require to be examined to complete the CS cycle:-


Weirs feed pump  
Ballast pumps, except that in forward pump room.  
Oil fuel transfer pumps except that in forward pump room and forward steam pump.  
Auxiliary air receivers and compressor for starting air.

I shall be glad if you will state if the aft main feed pump now examined was a reciprocating pump or a turbine pump.
