We have to refer to our Reports No. 105481 forwarded today on the classification and conversion of the Steamer "STANFIRTH" ex "BEAULY FIRTH", and would advise you that it is proposed to charge for the classification of the hull a fee equal to twice the Special Survey B fee, as in the previous similar case of the "LINARIA".
