The Liverpool Surveyors state that they have been verbally informed by Messrs. D.Napier & Sons that they have received an order for four Deltic engines to be fitted into an ore carrier, belonging to the Westport Shipping Co.Ltd. of 3, St. Helen's Place, E.C.3.

The Westport Shipping Co. has been approached by telephone and state that they are not the Owners but merely Agents, the ship being the m.v. "MANO" No.90573 in the Register Book. They were unable to confirm whether or not this order has actually been placed.

IT IS SUBMITTED the Owners be directly approached and informed of the statement made to the Liverpool Surveyors, and requested to confirm if it is correct or otherwise.\*It should be pointed out that if they intend to retain classification of the ship with this Society, then the engines should be constructed under survey, and they should inform the Makers accordingly.
