Reverting to my letter of the 28th September, the Surveyors at Singapore have reported that this ship was under survey in November, when a satisfactory General Examination was carried out in drydock, the Donkey Boiler Survey held, and both screwshafts drawn for examination.

As a result of this inspection the Committee have agreed to the proposal to postpone the Special Survey until December, 1956.

It is noted from the records here that four years have elapsed since a number of machinery parts were examined and a copy of the form VE is enclosed indicating by an "X" the items which are required to be surveyed before completion of the current cycle of the Continuous Survey.

Please advise the Owners accordingly and arrange for the Continuous Survey to be advanced as soon as possible.

A record of drydocking 11,55 and notations of DBS. 11,55 and Screwshafts examination 11,55 have been assigned.
