I have to acquaint you that the Vessels named in your Reports of Survey, numbered below, have been classed as against the same expressed.

The case has now received the consideration of the Committee, who have agreed to the class being continued subject to the steering chains and cylinder block being renewed before the ship resumes service. The Owners' Agents should be informed accordingly.

5764 "BENMORE". As recommended. It is concluded that that main engine bolt which was renewed has been satisfactorily tested, but I shall be glad if you will forward a forging certificate in respect of this item.
