It is proposed to complete the survey as a C.S.

It is submitted that this proposal merits approval and the vessel is eligible to remain as classed, and WILL BE eligible for the record LMC CS (with date) when the survey has been completed. subject as recommended.

Examine:- Auxiliary air receiver,
Pumping arrangements,
Daily service oil fuel tanks,
Steam pipes (examine and test).
