Nature of Survey

When due

The 2nd S.S. No. 2 became due 3.27 and on the 4th ultimo the Owners were asked to furnish the usual undertaking, the vessel being laid up and for sale.

The Lisbon Surveyors now forward a letter from the Owners stating they do not desire to retain the classification.

The Surveyors add that the principle reason for the trawler being taken out of class is the action of the Authorities who insist on an excessively rigorous examination and ignore the fact that the vessel is classed.

It is submitted the class of this vessel be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu, indicating withdrawal of class at the Owners' request.
