Dear Sir,

Referring to your cable of the 2nd inst and letter of the same date, I now enclose original letter from the Owners of the "ALBERTO 1" and "ALBERTO 2", ex "SIRIUS" and "SIRIUS 2", with regard to having vessels taken out of class.

The principle reason for the several trawlers having been taken out of class recently is the action of the Authorities who, backed by the Law, insist on an excessively rigorous examination and ignore that the vessels are classed with the Society; double expense is thus incurred and the repairs compelled are, in my opinion, much above what is required for practical efficiency; Owners are very much annoyed at the situation and have personally expressed their regret at taking their vessels out of class.
