Dear Sir,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the Steam Trawler "SIRIUS 2", I am directed to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them a letter received from the Society's Surveyor at Lisbon, from which it appears that the vessel is laid up.

In the circumstances I have to say that as the year of grace allowed for the 2nd Special Survey No.2 has now expired, the Committee can only agree to her class in the Register Book remaining undisturbed for a period of twelve months, subject to the conditions usually required by them in similar cases, viz:- that the overdue survey and all necessary repairs be completed before the vessel again proceeds to sea, and that you undertake to have this done if she remain your property, and should she be offered for sale to inform intending purchasers that the class is allowed to remain subject to this being done.
