Outstanding items to complete the Survey must be summarised at the end of the Report. The reasons for Repairs must be stated. On account of Damage (the alleged cause of which must be stated) should be separated repairs due to other causes, and, besides being detailed in the body of the Report, be summarised in the form below. When, at a Special Survey, the Shell and Deck is drilled the results must be reported on Report 8(Dr). Whenever Anchors or Chain are replaced or retested the necessary particulars are to be given on Report 8(Eq) and to be attached to this Report.
